Project Update

The Project was referred to the Department of Climate Change, Energy, the Environment and Water (the Department) under the Environmental Protection and Biodiversity Conservation Act 1999 (EPBC Act) for confirmation on whether Commonwealth environmental approval is required.

In November 2025, the Department determined that further assessment and approval is not required.

OX2 are now progressing the project towards construction.

Participation is voluntary, and all responses will remain strictly confidential. The survey takes approximately 15 minutes to complete.




We look forward to progressing this important journey and sharing the launch of our RAP in 2026.
